#### Swimming Lessons

The Year 6 children have been enjoying their swimming lessons and we recognize what an important life skill this is for our children. This year we have been able to provide these lessons for free.

Due to a substantial rise in the cost of transport and the financial pressures upon us all, we are walking the children to and from Braunstone swimming baths. The school can not afford to pay the transport costs for all pupils and we are reluctant to ask parents to pay for the bus transport. There has been some reasonable parental concerns about children walking with wet hair on cold days but we ask for your understanding as we try to ensure that swimming is free for all pupils this year.

We would suggest that a combination of swimming caps to keep hair dry and a warm coat and hat to wear are cheap and effective ways to help keep the children warm.

We will keep this under review. Thank you for your understanding and support.
