REMINDER.. Year 6 children moving to secondary school from August 2022

Online applications for secondary schools are now open. Applications can be made online at <u>Starting secondary school</u> (<u>leicester.gov.uk</u>) and will need to be submitted by no later than Monday **31 October 2022.** If you apply after this date, your application will be considered as late and you may miss out on your choice of school. Please remember that if you are applying for a Catholic school you must also complete the Supplementary Form.
