Behaviour at CTK

We set the highest standards of behaviour at Christ the King for our pupils because we know that pupil behaviour is strongly correlated to educational outcomes. Therefore, we will continue our work on the Behaviour Curriculum this half term by revisiting some of the behaviours and routines that we taught the children at the beginning of the year.

We teach our children the importance of being focussed in class by giving their teachers their attention so they can learn really well. This is captured in our acronym SLANT. Please see the poster below.

We also teach the pupils to be speak with confidence and articulate their answers and questions in class in a 'university voice' This is captured in our acronym SHAPE. We want children to speak in full sentences, loudly and clearly so that everyone can hear what they say. It would be wonderful if you could support us by encouraging good SHAPE answers at home too!

Year 1 Indian Dancing

On Wednesday, Year 1 had a special visitor called Sunita who came into school to tell the children about a festival that she celebrates called Diwali. She taught them about her Hindu beliefs and the children listened to the story of Diwali. After that, the children had the chance to dress up in Indian style clothes and had a go at some traditional Indian dances. The children then wrote a recount of their time with Sunita as part of the English unit.
