We have recently updated our Attendance and Punctuality Policy following parental feed-back last year and this can be accessed via our <u>school website</u>.



#### **Parent Curriculum Meetings**

Over the next month, parents will be invited into school for a parent introduction meeting. The purpose of these meetings will be to:

#### Uniform

In line with our behaviour policy, we are asking all children to 'Dress to Impress!' Children should aim to look smart at all times.
