A still life is a picture of objects that do not move.

Sometimes still lifes are a group of natural objects, like food, flowers, fruit or vegetables.

Sometimes they are paintings or drawing of groups of objects made by people, like cooking pots, bottles, household objects.



The items are arranged in a certain way and then the artist looks at the object and studies their shapes. The artist also looks at where the light falls and the shadows the object

Paul Cezanne 1839-1906
Paul was a French painter

Cezanne painted slowly believing that he truly needed to understand and observe his subject matter.

Cezanne wanted to represent real life in simple forms.

Key Vocabulary

Still life	An arrangement of objects that aren't alive.
Tone	How light or dark a shape is.
composition	The way objects have been arranged in an art work.
highlights	Where the light is strongest on a object.
shadow	Darker areas where there is less light on an object.
Viewfinder	viewfinder can be used to isolate a small section of something to draw.
Charcoal	Charcoal is a lightweight black carbon residue produced by strongly heating wood
