


Year 1 Art (Painting): Piet Mondrian

How to apply paint to paper using brush strokes.



To know to wash brushes between colours to ensure that the colours do not mix.

To control the paint and brush to paint within the lines.

To be able to draw straight lines with a ruler.

To be able draw horizontal and vertical lines.



Piet Mondrian- 1872-1944

He came from Amersfoort, Netherlands. He was a Dutch painter who is regarded as one of the greatest artists of the 20th century. He created a style of art that was called "neoplasticism".

The fashion designer <u>Yves Saint Laurent</u>'s featured shift dresses in blocks of primary colour with black bordering, which were inspired by Mondrian.

Key Vocabulary

Brush Stroke A mark made by a paintbrush drawn across a surface.

Colour Block Contrasting blocks or panels of solid, typically bright colour.

Shape The outline of someone or something.

Line A long, narrow mark or band.

Abstract Existing in thought or as an idea but not having a physical or concrete existence.

Horizontal/Vertical. Horizontal: lying flat or level. Vertical: an upright structure.
