




<b>Monarch</b>	A ruler of a country	 <p>The red rose was the badge of the Lancastrians</p>  <p>The white rose was the badge of the Yorkists</p>	<p><b>Sticky</b> Richard III knowledge</p> <p>Richard III reigned in the 15<sup>th</sup> century</p> <p>Richard III was believed to have put his two nephews in the Tower of London so that he could become king.</p> <p>The remains of Richard III were discovered under a car park in Leicester in 2012.</p> <p>Richard III died during the Battle of Bosworth in Leicestershire.</p> <p>The Battle of Bosworth was the last battle of the War of the Roses, fought between the House of Lancaster and the House of York</p>
