Apollo 11	The mission that Neil Armstrong and other crew members, Buzz Aldrin and Michael Collins went on to travel to the moon.
Astronaut	A person trained to travel to space.
Space	The area that contains the entire world and its events. Earth is a planet in space.
Earth	The planet on which we live.
Orbit	The path an object takes in space. The moon orbits the Earth. So, the moon travels around the Earth.
Timeline	A graph of events in the order that they happened.
Past	Time gone by. Events that have already happened.

- He joined NASA in 1962.
- His first trip into space was aboard Gemini 8.
- In 1969 he went aboard Saturn 5 and became the first man to walk on the moon on the Apollo 11 Mission.
- The moon landing happened on 16th July 1969.
- After stepping onto the moon, Neil Armstrong was heard saying: "That's one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind."
