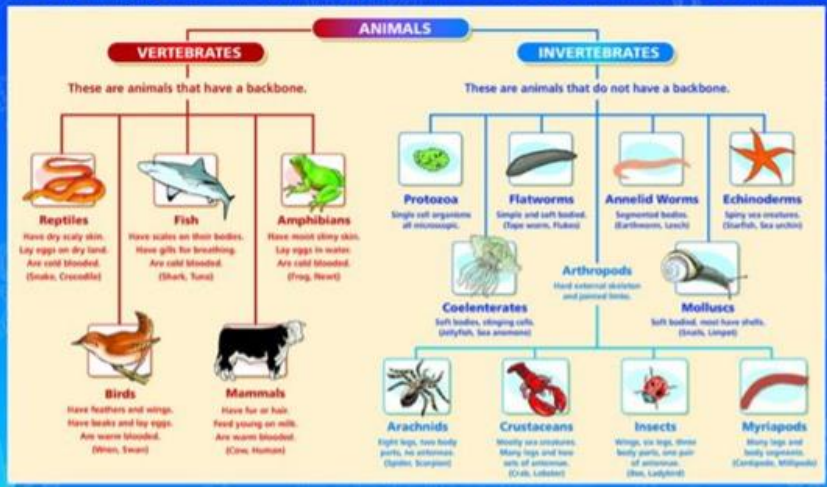

CLASSIFICATION OF ANIMALS

This is the grouping together of animals with similar characteristics. Animals can be classed as either vertebrates or invertebrates.



Key Vocabulary	Definition
Classification Key	A set of questions about the characteristics of living things used to identify a living thing or decide which group it belongs to.
Respiration	a process which all living things do involving the production of energy, typically through the intake of oxygen (breathing).
Sensitivity	All organisms are able to sense changes in their environment and will respond accordingly.
Reproduction	Reproduction is the creation of a living thing from an existing organism.
Excretion	the removal of waste products from an organism.
Habitat	The natural home or environment of an animal, plant or other organism
Organism	Any living thing such as an animal, plant or single celled life
Nutrition	In order for organisms to survive they require food for energy.
