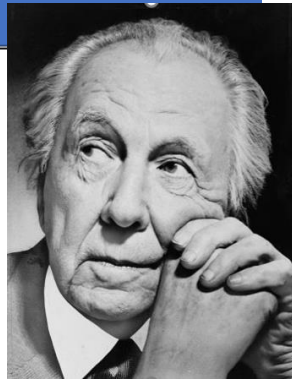
Key Knowledge

Frank Lloyd Wright is an example of an architect and architects design buildings. He was American and lived and worked at the beginning of the 20th century.

Architectural drawing is more precise than sketching (rulers can be used).

Perspective allows us to tell what is closest to the viewer and what is further away.

That lines of perspective disappear towards a vanishing point.



Frank Lloyd Wright

1867-1959
American architect, designer, writer, and educator. He designed more than 1,000 structures over a creative period of 70 years.

Key Vocabulary

architect	A designer of buildings.
Organic architecture	Designing buildings in harmony with the landscape.
Vanishing point	The point in the distance where things disappear from view.
Horizon	The line at which the Earth's surface and sky appear to meet.
perspective	The art of drawing solid objects on a 2D surface so as to give the right impression of their height, width and depth.
