### The Rule of Law assembly

Mrs Glassford and Mrs Marshall led our Weekly Word assembly on the 'Rule of Law.' as part of our continued work on British Values this half term. We celebrated the Feast of St Thomas Aquinas on Tuesday by joining together virtually with the 8000 children across the other 22 schools in the Trust.

The chaplaincy team joined our family of schools at English Martyrs' to celebrate the feast day of St Thomas Aquinas, the patron saint of our trust. The mass was celebrated by Fr David Cain and other members of the clergy. Our chaplains contributed to the Mass offering by stamping their thumb prints onto a school poster to represent each unique person at Christ the King. All the schools in the trust completed their own posters and it was lovely to see so many thumb prints representing the thousands of children and young people our trust serves.
