New Parents Meeting

Thank you to all the parents who were able to join us for our New Parents' Meeting on Wednesday evening. It was wonderful opportunity for the Early Years teaching team and Senior Leaders to meet you and hopefully answer any questions you might have. We are very much looking forward to working closely with you over the next seven years, supporting your child to believe and achieve at Christ the King.

Transition Morning for ALL Children

On the morning of <u>Wednesday 14th June</u>, the children will have the opportunity to spend some time with their new teacher and teaching assistant for the next academic year. The children will bring home a transition booklet to share with you, which will include a photo of their new teacher, a photo of their new classroom, a letter from their teacher and a summer challenge. We hope you find this information useful.

Year 2 Transition

On Wednesday 14th June, we ask that all current Year 2 children are dropped off to the **main playground gate** on the **Junior Site** at **8:15am**. They will then spend some time on the Junior Site with their new teachers. The Year 3 teaching team will then walk the children back to the infant site before lunchtime. The Year 2 children can then be collected at home time as normal from the infant site.

Year 2 children who would normally attend breakfast club at the infant site are very welcome to access the junior breakfast club from 7:45am. Please walk your Year 2 children up the pedestrian steps entrance and sign your child in with a member of CTK staff if you would like your child to attend the junior breakfast club on Wednesday morning.

JuniorSTEM – Lego Robotics workshops for Year 6

On Monday, the Year 6 children enjoyed a fantastic CAD workshop with Junior STEM Robotics. Ian, who facilitated the workshop, was brilliant at explaining and modelling how the technology is used to create algorithms, make objects move, change colour and make sounds through Bluetooth. He also talked to the children about careers in technology, engineering and mechanics.

The children used Lego to build a drumming monkey then made it move using a coding app on iPads. They had lots of fun, learnt a lot about coding and Computer Aided Design and, best of all, worked brilliantly with their learning partners.
