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	Key Vocabulary	
Mock-up	Quick 3D modelling using easy to work materials. Useful for checking proportions and scale.	
Pattern	A shape drawn to exact shape and size.	
Seam allowance	Extra fabric allowed for joining, usually 15mm.	
Specification	This describes what a product has to do.	
Tacking	Large running stitches to hold pieces of fabric together temporarily.	
Working Drawing	Detailed drawing containing all information needed to make the product.
