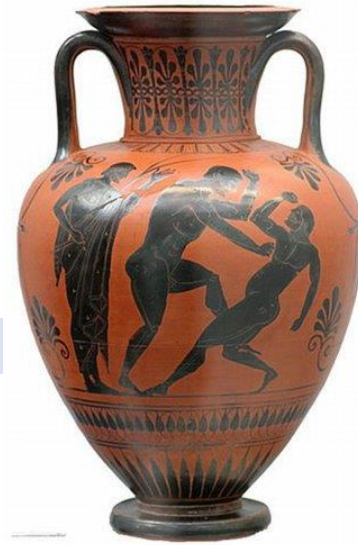
Key Knowledge

...dip glaze a pot

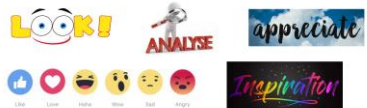
...paint a pot with a design

Key Vocabulary

vessel	A container for holding liquids or solids.
ceramic	Hardened clay. This can be earthenware, stoneware or porcelain.
score and slip	A method of joining two pieces of clay together by etching each piece and adding water.
fire	To bake the clay pot in a special pottery oven
glaze	To cover the surface of the fired clay in a paint-like solution that forms a wipe-clean coloured surface after further firing.
