Key Vocabulary

Three-dimensional

having or appearing to have length, breadth, and depth.

Representative

Portrayal of someone or something.

Abstract

Visual language of shape, form, colour and line to create artwork which may not represent something from the world.

Contemporary

Modern artwork produced from the 2nd half of the 20th century.

Carving

Using tools to shape something from a material by scraping away portions of that material.

Casting

Making a mould and then pouring a liquid material, such as molten metal or plastic into the mould.

Commission

Requesting the creation of a piece, often on behalf of another.

Modernism

The search and experimentation to find new forms of expression.

Negative space

The space outside of or between shapes

Contour

An outline representing the form of something.
