### **Parent Curriculum Meetings**

# <u>Uniform</u>

In line with our behaviour policy, we are asking all children to 'Dress to Impress!' Children should aim to look smart at all times. All children will be expected to wear full school uniform and to wear it well: shirts should be tucked in; schools shoes must be worn (no boots or trainers); nails should not be painted and hair (below shoulder length) should be tied back. On PE days, children should attend school wearing a white polo t-shirt, navy shorts, a <u>plain</u> navy tracksuit and trainers.


