Rainbow Reader

Our vision for reading at CTK is:

To achieve this, we are encouraging our children to read widely and often, at home and at school! We are introducing a new initiative called **Rainbow Readers** - If your child reads four times or more every week, and this is recorded in their reading records, they will receive a star sticker. For your child to receive a star sticker, please record clearly in their reading records each time they have read at home. At the end of every half term, if your child has received a star sticker every week, they have become a Rainbow Reader and will receive a certificate for their hard work.
