

Dear Parents/Carers,

This week we received a letter from Damien Hinds, Minister for schools, to congratulate the school on our outstanding achievement in the 2023 Phonics Check. We want every child to be a reader by age 7. We achieve this by ensuring every child has a firm grasp of phonics as the basis for early reading. 96% of pupils in Year 1 at Christ the King met the expected standard in the check which puts our school in the top 4% of all primary schools in the country. Congratulations to the children, thank you to the parents and carers and well done to the CTK Infants team.

This morning we enjoyed a wonderful poetry recital assembly all about the seasons performed by Miss Rawling's class. Thank you to all the pupils in 1ER for all their hard work and preparation over the past few weeks. The children confidently performed 'Bed in Summer' by Robert Stevenson and 'Winter Spring Summer Fall' by Helen Moore, as well as the song 'Let it Go' from the film Frozen. It was lovely to see the children not only learning these poems off by heart but also to hear what they had learned about the poets and how it linked with the learning so far this year.

As ever, the children were given a mission: *Speak Out, Reach Out* to a trusted adult if they are worried or concerned about something.
