Wind and Fire	Wind and fire are symbols used for the Holy Spirit which are symbols of power and energy. Wind and Fire bring a large amount of energy to the surface.	
Energy	Christians believe that the gift of the Holy Spirit within them gives them energy and the power to live in the way of Jesus.	
Gifts	The gifts of the Holy Spirit enable people to live as Christians and help people to lead good lives, these gifts should be used to help others. There are seven gifts: <i>wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, fear of the Lord.</i>	
Holy Spirit	The Holy Spirit is your Guide in choosing, He speaks for the right choices we make. The disciples are filled with the Holy Spirit which gave them the energy and power to carry the Gospel of Jesus to the world. The Holy Spirit inspires the lives of Christians.	
Rosary	The rosary is a set of prayers, usually represented by a set of beads used to aid prayer, allowing them to remain focused. Catholics offer their prayers for the life of Jesus and call on Mary to offer their prayers to God.	
Glorious Mysteries	There are 5 Glorious Mysteries that explore the aftermath of Jesus' death including His Resurrection and Ascension to heaven, the descent of the Holy Spirit and the end of Mary's earthly life but the beginning of her heavenly one.	

Christians believe that the gift of the Holy Spirit within them gives them energy and the power to live the way of Jesus.

The symbols used for the Holy Spirit – wind and fire – are symbols of power and energy.

At Pentecost, the disciples were filled by the gifts of the Holy Spirit and went out courageously to carry the Gospel of Jesus to the whole world.
