Liturgy of the Word

Liturgy of the Eucharist

Key word	Definition	Image
<b>Eucharist</b>	The <b>Eucharist</b> is the true presence of Jesus Christ. The bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ.	
<b>Mass</b>	<b>Mass</b> is a celebration. It is also the most important form of worship in the Catholic Church.	
<b>Vessels</b>	Sacred <b>vessels</b> are important objects used during the Eucharistic Prayer and Communion Rite. These include the chalice and ciborium, which are used to hold the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ.	
<b>Liturgy of the Word</b>	This is where we listen to the <b>Word of our Lord</b> . We also get a key message from this which helps us to live as good Christians.	
<b>Liturgy of the Eucharist</b>	This is where we prepare to receive the <b>Body and Blood of Christ</b> . The <b>Eucharistic Prayer</b> is part of this too.	
<b>Holy Communion</b>	<b>Communion</b> is a way for Christians to say thank you to God for Jesus' life and death.

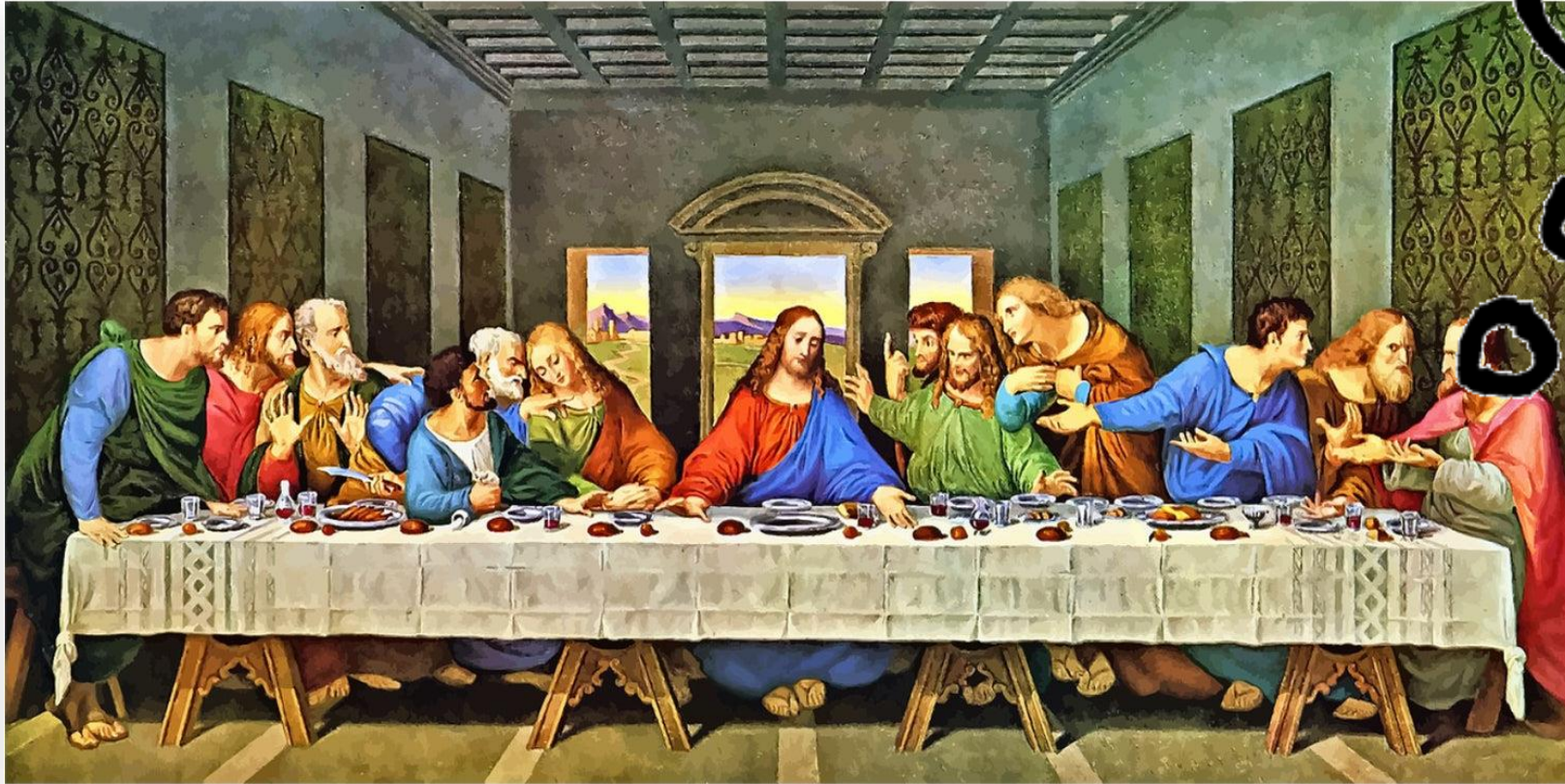

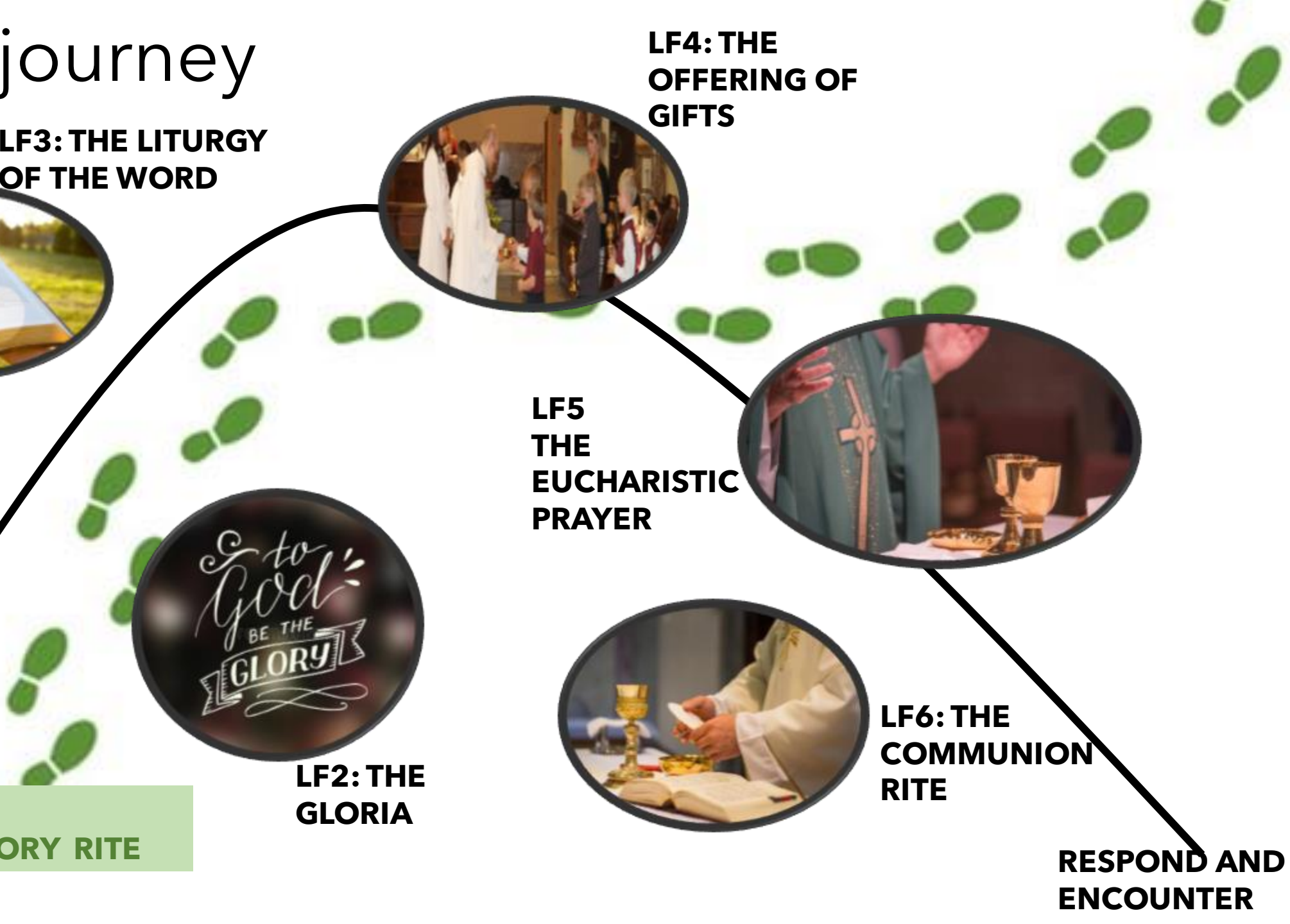
