Rome, Florence, Milan, Venice are major cities in Italy. Have you visited any?

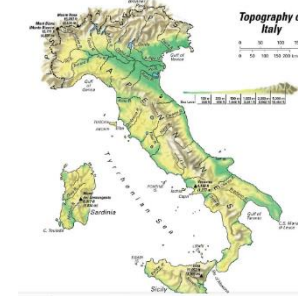


Italian food is famous throughout the world. Which is your favourite?
