
Poetry Recital 4HB








Faith in Action - Mary's Meals Fundraising

Worry Assembly

Just like adults, sometimes children can feel worried or anxious. In addition to our daily prayers and putting our Faith into action, we arranged for the school nurse team to come in to school and talk to the children about worries and their feelings. The children shared some of the things they worry about and the nurse talked about what they can do to help themselves and who they can talk to if they are feeling worried.



To ensure our children feel listened to, we have a physical 'Worry Monster' teddy in each classroom. The children write down any worries - or simply their name - if they want a chat with a trusted adult and post it in the Worry Monster. The classroom teachers check the Worry Monster regularly and address those worries in the best way for that individual child. This has had a very positive impact on our listening culture at CTK.

Calling Foundation Governors


Are you looking for a way to live out your Faith and serve your local community at the same time?
