Punctuality and Attendance Snapshot

On the last Friday of every half term we will email the attendance and punctuality for every pupil via Arbor. This will enable all parents to have a snapshot of their child's attendance and punctuality compared to the school's average. We hope this will further improve attendance rates at CTK. Thank you for your continued support with this.

There is a **new National Framework for Penalty notices** and any unauthorised attendance will be tracked over a <u>three year period</u> for each pupil.

Please note that the fines have increased and there will be no reductions in payments for second offences. Third offences will proceed to a magistrates court. Please see the quick guide here. This will come into effect from August 2024.

Year 2 Transition

On Wednesday 12th June, we ask that all current Y2 children are dropped off to the **main playground gate** on the **Junior Site** at **8:15am**. They will spend some time on the Junior Site with their new teachers. The Year 3 teaching team will then walk the children back to the infant site before lunchtime. The Year 2 children can then be collected at home time as normal from the infant site.

Moving from the Infant site to the Junior site in Year 3 can feel like a big change for our children and their families and we want to make this transition as smooth as possible.
