Our target is always to have attendance above 97%. Last week, attendance across all year groups was 95.8%. Your support with ensuring all children have a good level of attendance is wonderful. Please remember that excellent attendance leads to amazing achievements.

Punctuality and Attendance Snapshot

On the last Friday of every half term we will email the attendance and punctuality for every pupil via Arbor. This will enable all parents to have a snapshot of their child's attendance and punctuality compared to the school's average. We hope this will further improve attendance rates at CTK. Thank you for your continued support with this.

There is a **new National Framework for Penalty Notices** and any unauthorised attendance will be tracked over a <u>three year period</u> for each pupil.

Please note that the fines have increased and there will be no reductions in payments for second offences. Third offences will proceed to a magistrates court. Please see the quick guide here. This will come into effect from August 2024.

Year 5 Residential Experience

The day started with the children attending the National Space Centre where they explored all the exhibits and were able to view what it is like to be an astronaut, as part of an immersive experience in the Space Centre's planetarium.

We were very blessed to have members from the Leicester Astronomical Society who delivered a wonderful range of activities about space to our children. This included looking at images through enhanced telescopes, handling fragments of meteorites and further knowledge about our solar system. After a wonderful evening of activities, it was then juice, biscuits with a bedtime story read from an astronaut in space! What a fantastic experience for all!
