Our Catholic Mission

Mrs Glassford, Mrs Marshall and our Junior School Councillors led our Weekly Word assembly on the theme of 'Democracy'. They explained what the upcoming general election means in an accessible and interesting way. The children learned what democracy means ("Rule by the People") and we discussed how we promote this in our school community.

At CTK, we aim to instil the value of Democracy by: voting for school councillors, house captains, chaplains, eco-warriors etc; holding mock elections when there is a general election, learning about democracy in our history lessons; holding debates in our classes; completing pupil surveys/pupil interviews and listening to the pupils' opinions and ideas.

As ever, the children were set a mission. Our mission this week was to find out more about the general election and the parties involved, talking to their families and friends about the upcoming general election and what they learned about in assembly this week.

REMINDER... Punctuality and Attendance Snapshot

On the last Friday of every half term we will email the attendance and punctuality for every pupil via Arbor. This will enable all parents to have a snapshot of their child's attendance and punctuality compared to the school's average. We hope this will further improve attendance rates at CTK. Thank you for your continued support with this.

There is a new **National Framework for Penalty Notices** and any unauthorised attendance will be tracked over a <u>three year period</u> for each pupil.

Please note that the fines have increased and there will be no reductions in payments for second offences. Third offences will proceed to a magistrates court. Please see the quick guide here. This will come into effect from August 2024.
