Advent Fundraiser - Toys on the Table



Personal Development

Worry Assembly

Craig and Clare from the School Nurse Team visited both sites to deliver an assembly on the theme of worries earlier this week.

They talked to the children about how we feel a range of emotions and how normal it is to feel worried sometimes. They explained that a worry is when you think about a person/place or something you are going to do and you imagine something is going to go wrong. Clare talked through some examples of times children might feel worried and how worries can make our bodies feel. Finally, the children learned about strategies they might use to help them to stop feeling worried. These strategies included: speaking to a trusted adult, doing something they enjoy, and using a range of breathing and grounding techniques which we practiced together.
