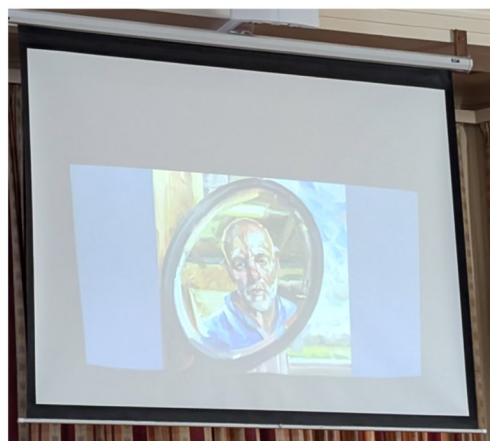
Rocksteady Assembly

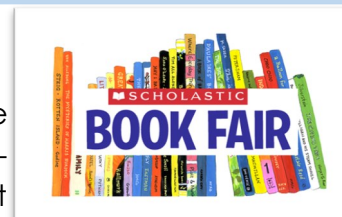


We are delighted that this enriching Forest School experience will be offered to all children in Reception, Year 1, and Year 2 throughout this academic year.
